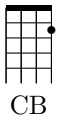
1. They seek him here, they seek him there



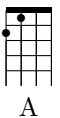
His clothes are loud but never square

Cos he's a dedicated follower of fashion



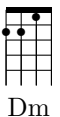

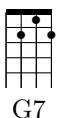
Round the boutiques of London town
